Solberg-Tallgrass Overpass Public Meeting

A public meeting to seek input and provide information for the Solberg-Tallgrass Overpass of I-229 is scheduled for Wednesday, January 20, 2010. The meeting will be held from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. in the band room of Explorer Elementary School, located at 4010 W. 82nd Street in Sioux Falls.

A brief, summarizing presentation will be given at approximately 6:15 p.m. Information will be available and displays set up to discuss and receive public input on the environmental assessment (E.A.) for the overpass project.

Information will be available on the acquisition of right-of-way, relocation assistance, and the environmental, social and economic effects of the Solberg-Tallgrass overpass project's location and design. URS, City of Sioux Falls and SDDOT staff will be available to answer questions and receive input. The open house will be informal, with one on one discussion available. Opportunity will also be made to provide for formal, written comments on the project.
