

SECTION 240 OBLITERATING OLD ROADS

240.1 DESCRIPTION

This work consists of scarifying, plowing, grading and harrowing of abandoned roads outside the limits of the new construction.

240.2 MATERIALS (Not Specified)

240.3 CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

After opening the new road to traffic, that portion of the road to be obliterated shall be graded to a contour which will blend with the contour of the adjoining land.

Obliteration or removal shall include flattening the backslopes and embankment slopes so that farm cultivation work can be satisfactorily done. Portions of the obliterated road surface to be covered with less than one foot (300 mm) of earth shall be scarified to a depth of not less than six inches (150 mm).

In areas of rock or rough topography not adaptable to cultivation, the desired obliteration and disposal will be detailed on the plans.

240.4 METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

The item of obliterating old roads will be measured to the nearest station of 100 linear feet (0.01 kilometer) along the centerline of the old road.

240.5 BASIS OF PAYMENT

Payment for obliterating old roads will be made at the contract unit price per station (0.01 kilometer), inclusive of all labor and equipment required.
