Project Overview:

- Project will completely reconstruct US Hwy 14 (6th Street) from 20th Ave to 34th Ave.
- 22nd Ave will be reconstructed 500' west, north and south of the 6th Street intersection.

Project Features

- 6th Street will have 2 lanes in each direction, plus turn lanes and a center raised median.
- The adjacent service roads will be modified and/or removed for traffic safety.
- The existing bridges over I-29 will be reconstructed to be one single bridge.
- 9" concrete surfacing will be installed for 6th Street and 22nd Avenue.
- An improved storm drainage system will be installed along the project.
- A new 8" watermain will be installed, both west and east of I-29.
- Sanitary sewer will be installed along 22nd Ave and east of I-29.
- Decorative light poles will be installed along the project.



Project Phasing

- The project will be completed in **3 Major Phases**.
➢ A map of this phasing is shown below and explained in the legend to the right.
- Preparatory work is occurring today and over the next weeks. (*temp signals, widening*)
- Phase 1 will begin in early April.
- The intersection of 22nd Avenue will be closed for 2-3 months starting in May at the end of the SDSU semester.
- Phase 3 (service roads and median) will likely be completed next year.
