## 27TH ST & HWY 14A/COLORADO BLVD

Bulletin No. 11—August 15, 2016



I hope everyone had a safe and enjoyable Sturgis Rally. Construction resumed today, Monday August 15, with lane closures on I-90 to prepare for one-lane two-way traffic in the newly completed eastbound lanes on Tuesday or Wednesday this week. Traffic was switched on Colorado Blvd to the newly completed lanes today. 27<sup>th</sup> St south of Colorado Blvd was closed and detoured on 4<sup>th</sup> Ave to Heritage Dr and is scheduled to re-open in 45 days on September 29.

The I-90 westbound lanes, with the exception of block-outs at the ramps, 27th Street south of I-90, Colorado Boulevard and the east half of the new bridge are scheduled for completion by November 10, 2016.

The traffic signals at the intersection of 27<sup>th</sup> St and Colorado Blvd are being taken down and will go back to a 4-way stop configuration. The on and off ramps will continue to be a 3-way stop configuration.

Weekly project meetings are open to the public and will resume every Thursday at 2:00 PM in the Hudson Hall (Room C), 222 W Hudson St, Spearfish, SD.
