

I-90 EXIT 14 INTERCHANGE

27TH ST & HWY 14A/COLORADO BLVD

SPEARFISH, SD

Bulletin No. 22—March 28, 2017



Work has resumed for the construction season. The contractor has shifted traffic to the east half of 27th St north of I-90 and begun grading operations on the west half. The contractor has the bridge demolition completed on all but the center bent and the south span, which is expected to be finished soon.

As part of the work on 27th St, the signal at 1st Ave has been changed to flashing red since there is no longer the width to accommodate turn lanes. We will monitor traffic flows and make changes if needed, but it appears to be working well. We ask that motorists have patience when going through the intersection. If everyone is courteous and takes turns, any delays at this intersection should be minimal.

Now that work has resumed, be on the lookout for flaggers, construction workers and equipment adjacent to the roadway, construction equipment entering and exiting the work zone, as well as suddenly slowing, merging and stopped traffic. Motorists are also asked to slow down through the work zone.
