Grading and storm sewer work on the west half of 27<sup>th</sup> St north of I-90 is complete and paving has begun. The paving of this section was delayed due to the wet weather, but paving should be completed in the near future.

The north MSE wall is nearly complete. Pile driving will resume on the south side of I-90 next week.

Paving at 26<sup>th</sup> St on Colorado Blvd is complete and open to traffic. The contractor has switched traffic onto White's Canyon Motors' east approach and plans to complete the west approach in 2 weeks. The contractor is also working to complete the paving on 27<sup>th</sup> St south of the bridge, the paving in the northwest corner of the 27<sup>th</sup> St and Colorado Blvd intersection, the sidewalk on the east side of 27<sup>th</sup> St south of Colorado Blvd, and the raised median on Colorado Blvd.

The contractor paved the temporary surface at the top of the westbound ramps last week, eliminating the bumps and potholes. Thank you for your patience.

The contractor cleaned up and seeded the south side of Colorado Blvd west of 27<sup>th</sup> St last week. East of Colorado Blvd will be done as soon as the approach and sidewalk work is complete.

The raised median on Colorado Blvd, once complete, will control access on Colorado Blvd. There will be only a few locations you will be able to turn left. This should reduce congestion due to motorists waiting for gaps in traffic to turn left. Left turns will be allowed at 27<sup>th</sup> St, 26<sup>th</sup> St, White's Canyon Motors east entrance, and Heritage Plaza by KFC. The Phillips 66 approach, Pizza Ranch approach, and White's Canyon Motors west approach will be restricted to right-in, right-out access. Motorists will have to make a U-turn or find an alternate route to make a left turn from these locations.

Please continue to be on the lookout for flaggers, construction workers and equipment adjacent to the roadway, construction equipment entering and exiting the work zone, as well as suddenly slowing, merging and stopped traffic. Motorists are also asked to slow down through the work zone.

Weekly project meetings are open to the public and are every Thursday at 2:00 PM in the Hudson Hall (Room C), 222 W Hudson St, Spearfish, SD.
