27TH ST & HWY 14A/COLORADO BLVD

SPEARFISH, SD

Bulletin No. 35—September 26, 2017



The bridge crew has completed the second of three deck pours. The remaining deck pour should be completed sometime this week. Crews will then pour the concrete barrier wall along the west edge of the bridge. Then the backfilling at the north and south ends of the bridge can begin.

Concrete crews have continued paving operations on the westbound on ramp and the eastbound off ramp. Paving has been completed on the last portion of the northbound lanes of 27th St. Two-way traffic will be placed on these northbound lanes in a couple of weeks. Removal of the old westbound off ramp is underway. The bike path at northwest corner of Colorado Blvd and 27th St has been constructed. Sidewalk has also been poured in front of the Quality Inn and the Hampton Inn. Miscellaneous concrete pours for curb and gutter and sidewalk will continue throughout the project.

Crews have also completed paving the intersection at 27th St and 1st Ave. The truck detour on North 27th St and Industrial Drive around the 1st Ave and 27th St intersection has been removed. The truck detour has been restored back to its original condition. The city portion of the 1st Ave project is scheduled to begin next week.

The electrical contractor has the luminaires on the westbound off ramp working. The temporary traffic signals at the intersection of 27th St and 1st Ave have been removed. Concrete footings for the new traffic signals are being installed at this intersection. Lighting under the bridge is also being installed. Crews continue to install concrete footings, conduit and wiring throughout the project.

Please continue to be on the lookout for flaggers, construction workers and equipment adjacent to the roadway, construction equipment entering and exiting the work zone, as well as suddenly slowing, merging and stopped traffic. Motorists are also asked to slow down through the work zone.
